AS WE GO TO PRESS, OUR TWIN TOWNS ARE TORN APART BY DIFFERENCES OF OPINIONS.

PARENTS ARE AT A TURMOIL OVER THE RULING OF SCHOOL BUS FARES. MANY THINK THAT THE ISSUE IS TRIVIAL WHEREAS WITH OTHERS IT IS A MAJOR THING.

\$1.50 PER STUDENT PER WEEK DOES NOT SOUND A LOT IN OUR COMMUNITIES BUT WITH A FAMILY OF THREE GOING TO SCHOOL, \$1.50 + \$1.25 + \$1.25 EQUALS A TOTAL OF \$4.00 PER WEEK. MULTIPLY THAT BY 4 1/3 BY 9 1/2 MONTHS PER YEAR AND YOU CAN ARRIVE AT A TIDY SUM. THE PARENTS FEEL THAT WE HAVE BEEN FLEECE ENOUGH, AND IT IS HIGH TIME THAT WE GET A RETURN ON OUR TAX DOLLAR.

FOR TOO LONG WE, THE PEOPLE OF THE TWIN COMMUNITIES HAVE BEEN RELYING ON THE IRON ORE COMPANIES TO GIVE US WHAT WE WANT. BUT HOW LONG CAN THESE COMPANIES KEEP PAYING THE SHOT? WE CANNOT BLAME THEM FOR CUTTING OFF THE SUBSIDIES. WE WANT ONLY A FAIR RETURN FOR OUR TAX DOLLAR.

TUESDAY MORNING SAW A FORTY PER CENT ABSENTEE IN THE J.R. SMALLWOOD SCHOOL, WABUSH; AND TEN PER CENT IN LABRADOR CITY SCHOOLS. THE AFTERNOON, IT WAS 90 - 95% IN WABUSH AND 20 - 30% IN LABRADOR CITY. IF THE PRESENT TREND CONTINUES, BY THURSDAY, IF IT BE NECESSARY, THE SCHOOL WILL HAVE 100% ABSENTEE.

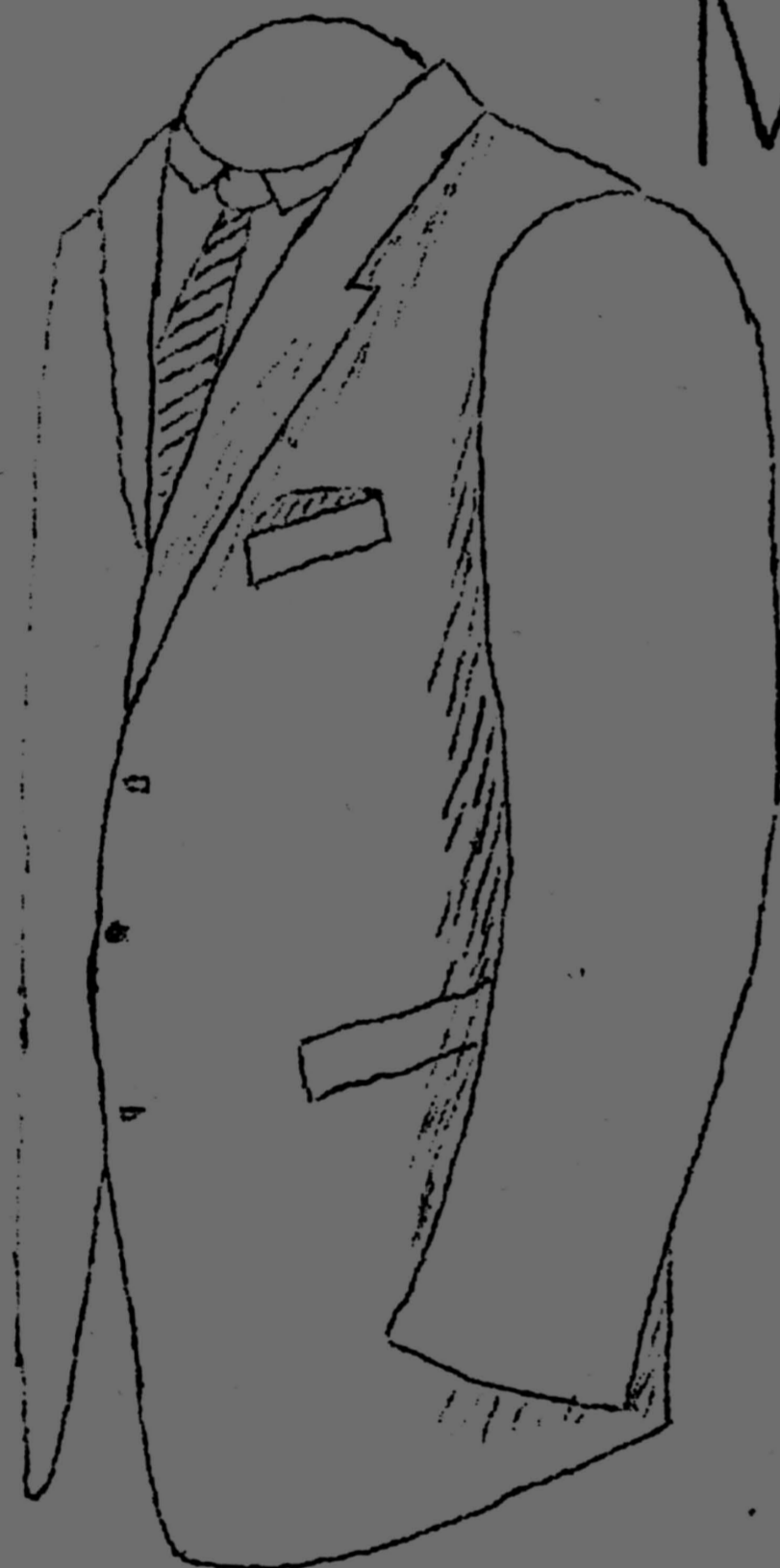

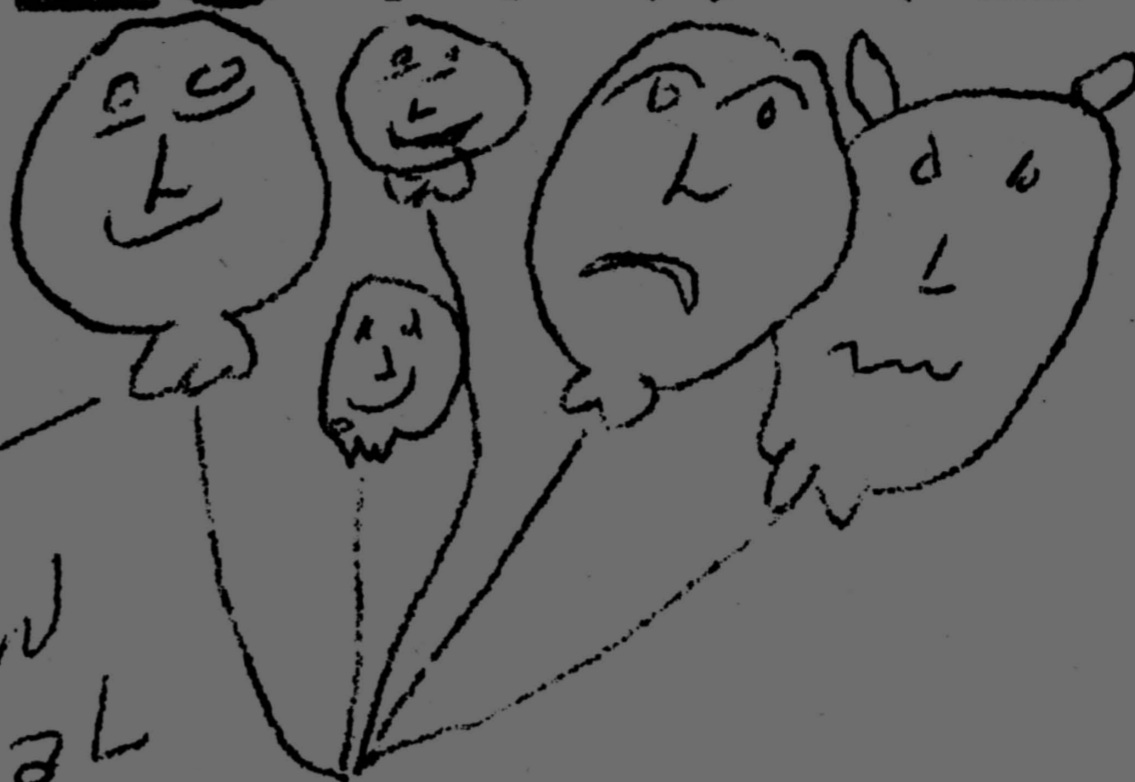
