THE NEWFOUNDLAND FOREST SERVICE -

Announces that a Forest Ranger and an Assistant Ranger have been stationed at Labrador City. The office is located at Camp Site, opposite Hussey Engineering Ltd., and the office and res. telephone number is 2470.

The public is reminded of the following regulations:

1. No person may light a fire without a permit except in a prepared location in a provincial park or except the fire be located 100 ft. from the nearest woods, within 4 ft. of water whose surface area exceeds 100 sq. ft., and the fire itself does not exceed a surface area of 4 sq. ft.
The penalty for failing to observe this regulation is imprisonment up to two years.
2. All non-residents must obtain a permit to travel in the forest area.
3. Smoking while travelling through Forest Lands is not permitted.
4. Pilots of seaplanes conveying fishing parties to parts of Labrador are required to have a permit.
5. Wherever possible, anyone locating a forest fire must endeavour to put it out. When the fire is beyond his control, he should contact the NFLD. FOREST SERVICE immediately.
6. Fishing regulations will also be enforced..

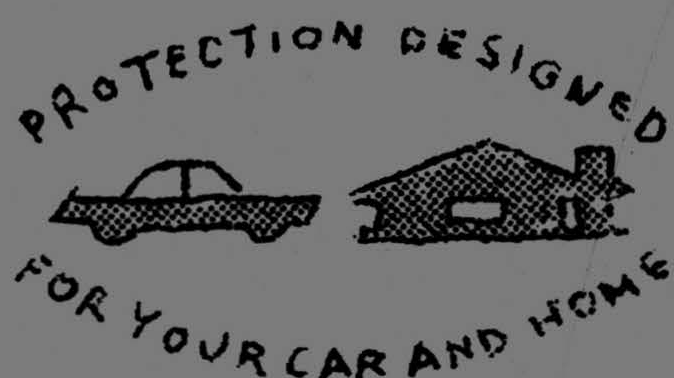
