REPORT FROM THE LABRADOR CITY YOUTH ASSOCIATION

The teenagers of Labrador City will NOT have an official Youth Centre this winter. Why? There are a number of reasons. However, we, the executive of the L.C.Y.A., are rather reluctant to justify our work, or lack of it, by a long list of excuses.

At a time such as this when we have, to a certain extent, failed in our plans of opening the new Youth Centre before the new year, we feel that we owe the citizens, especially the teenagers, some reason why they will not have their Youth Centre.

The main and most important reason is the weather. To build the basement at this time of year, even using specialized equipment, would be far too risky. We could have it done, and thus we could have our Youth Centre this winter, but, what of the spring and the eventual change in temperature and weather. To construct our Youth Centre in winter would cause too many headaches in the spring.

Many people have suggested that we should use the building as it stands. First, due to fire regulations we cannot operate our building so close to the church where it now stands. Second, our building is on the property of the Salvation Army Church and, because of their religious beliefs, which we honour and respect, we cannot operate an establishment such as we have planned, on their church's property.

There were other reasons, money problems, construction delays, miscalculations in the digging, and other technical headaches, but we will justify ourselves and our work no further. It is only left to say that we will NOT have a Youth Centre not this winter- not even this year, but, when spring comes to our city and the earth thaws, then is the time that our Youth Centre will be born.

All we ask is that you remain patient with us. Please do not lose faith in us. We, the executive of the L.C.Y.A. are still working for the teenagers of Labrador City, and we are still striving toward the completion of our Youth Centre, and so we will continue to do.

The issue of 1968 Newfoundland and Labrador Driver and Vehicle Licenses will commence on Jan 2nd, 1968 at the Motor Registration Office at St. John's, Corner Brook and Grand Falls.

Licenses may be obtained by mailing in application forms with prescribed fee or by visiting any one of the Offices of the Motor Registration Division.

The 1968 license plates will have red lettering on a white background with the legend "Canada's Happy Province".

Applicants are reminded that 1964 or older model vehicles require inspection before 1968 registration and in this connection appropriate inspection certificates should accompany such applications for registration.

It is also pointed out that where persons under 21 or over 65 years of age are seeking vehicle or driver licenses, proof of insurance must be filed with the Motor Registration Division before licenses can be issued.

Motorists should take note of the fact that the 1967 licenses expire on March 31st, 1968 and under no circumstances will an extension of validity be approved.

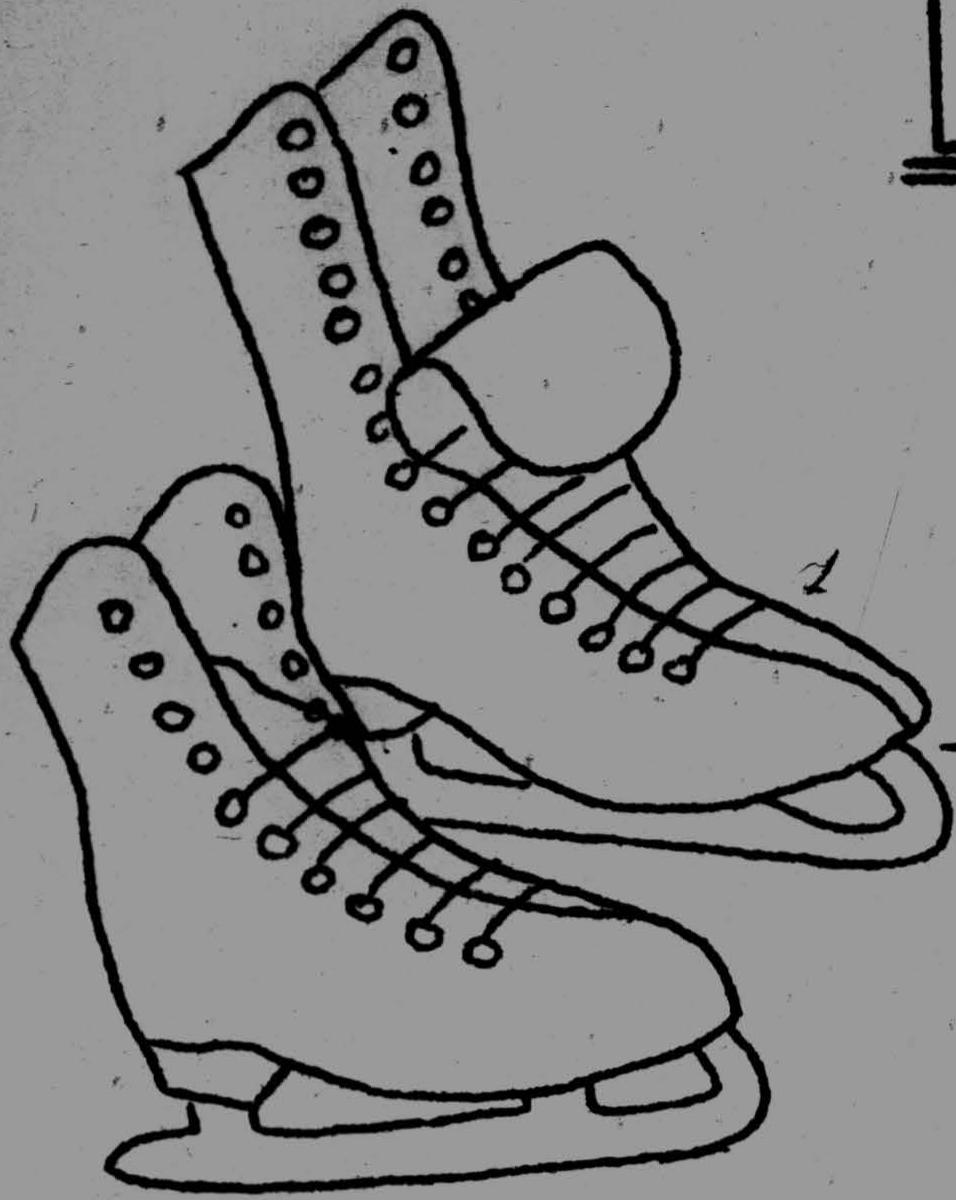

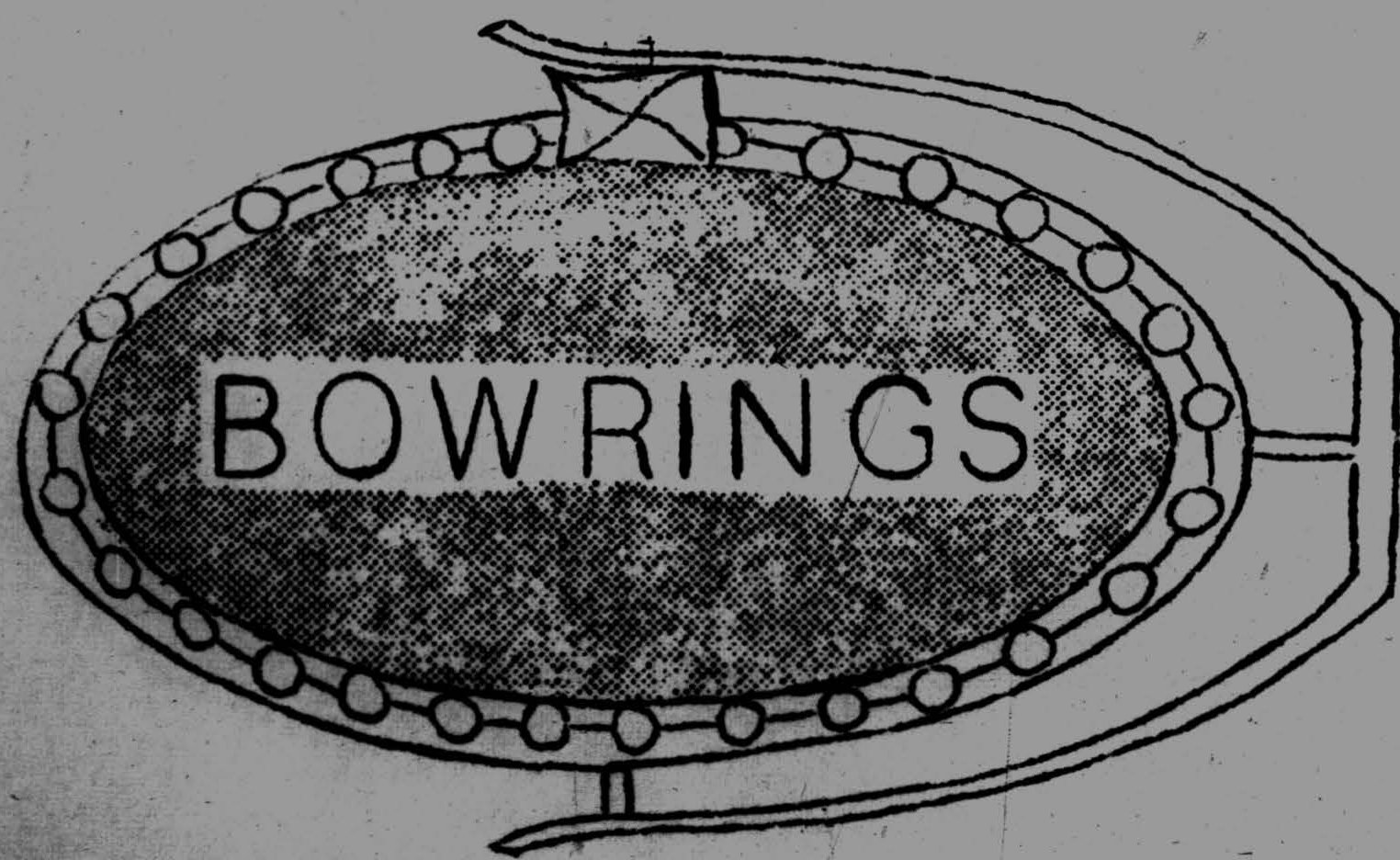
