With another three weeks yet to go before they return home, the students are really living every minute of this once-in-a-lifetime trip. Their french has improved tremendously as the teachers do not speak English to them so they have no choice but to speak french.

Last weekend the students drove to Lake Lucerne but the weather was so bad they ended their trip by taking in a James Bond movie, in french of course.

On their return to Lausanne on Sunday they experienced a small earthquake. Miss Journeaux reports that the room swayed a little, but she was assured by the nuns that it was only a small tremour and nothing to worry about.

The students are usually taken out on two excursions a week to various places of interest. One of these was a visit to some wine sellars where they were invited to sample the wine. They have also crossed the boarder twice, once into France and once into Italy.

Refreshments will be served to the participants after the show.

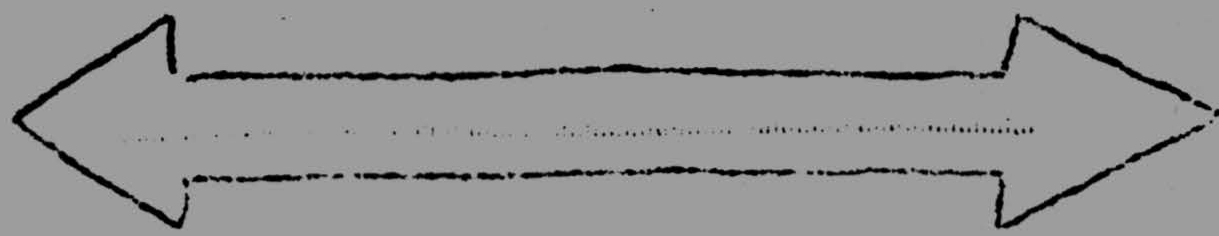

- SIMPLE RECIPES TO CUT OUT AND KEEP -

INGREDIENTS

BATTENBERG CAKE

METHOD

4 oz margarine  
4 oz sugar  
2 eggs  
6 oz self-raising flour  
A pinch of salt  
Milk to mix  
Vanilla essence  
1 tbsp.cocoa  
Jam  
8 oz almond icing  
Caster sugar.

Cream fat and sugar together and beat in the eggs. Sieve flour and salt and add to the creamed mixture, together with enough milk to give a dropping consistency. Divide the mixture into two portions, adding a few drops of vanilla essence to one half, and the cocoa and a little extra liquid to the other half. Put into two flat tins, and bake in a moderate oven (375° F) for about ½ hour. Turn out on to a wire tray and leave to cool.

.....

When cool trim edges off cakes and level tops. Halve strips and put together, alternating the colours. Spread cakes with warm jam and press firmly together. Roll out the almond paste so that it covers the cake. Brush crumbs from outside of cake and put on the almond paste, making a neat join. Crimp edges with finger and thumb.

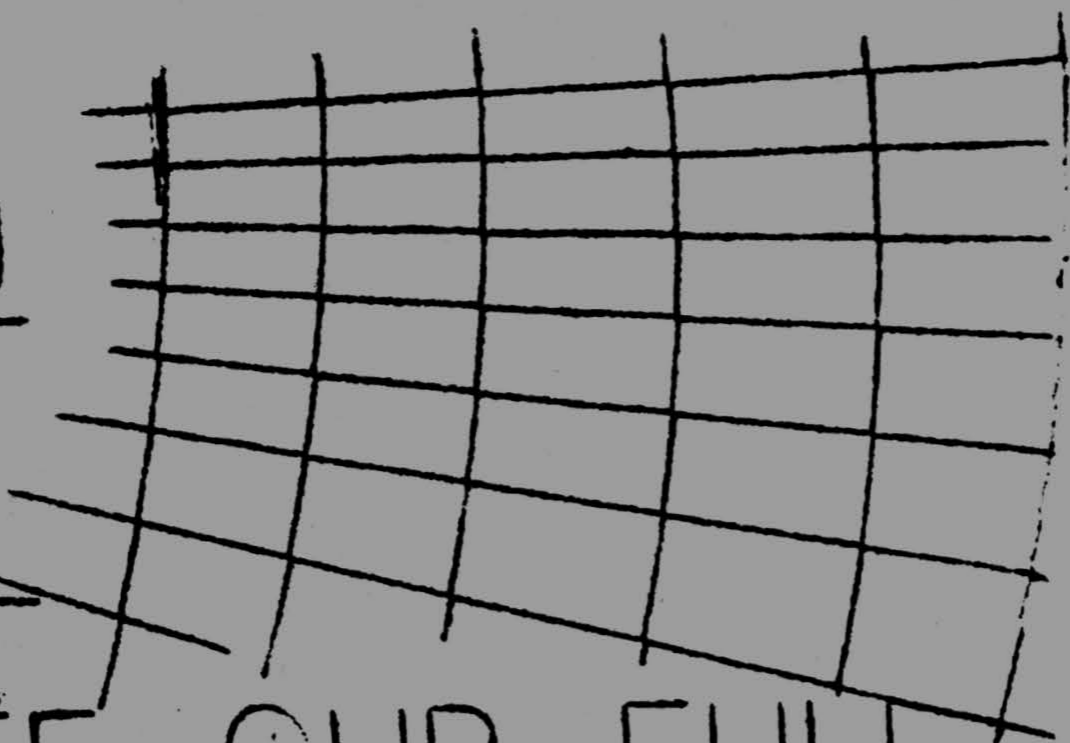
