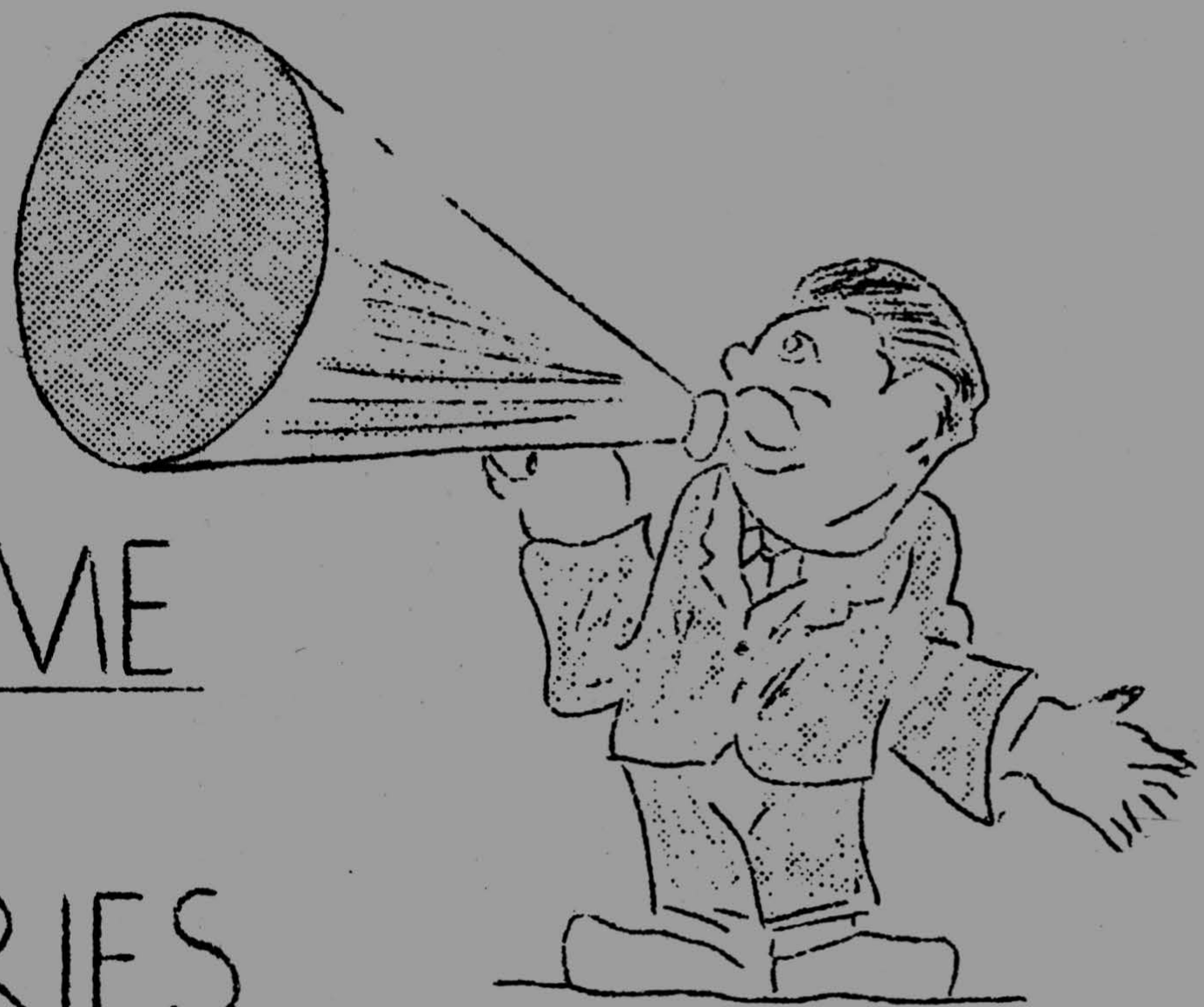

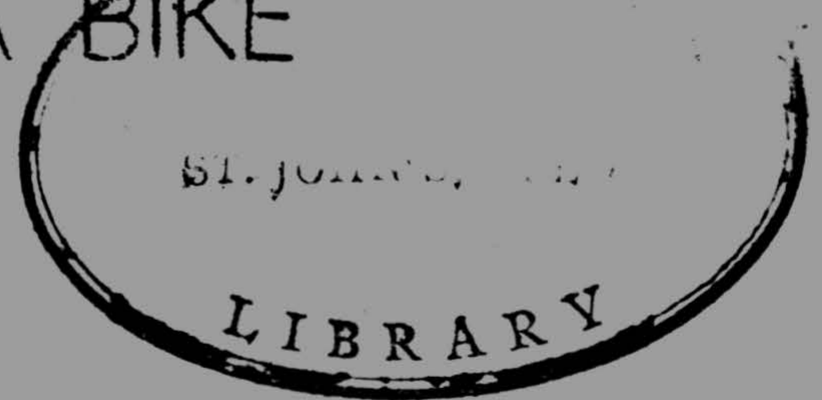

The provisions of the Motor Carrier Act No. 54, 1961, as amended by Act No. 14, 1968, have now been extended to the DISTRICT OF LABRADOR WEST, with effect from August 1st, 1968.

All persons operating a public passenger or freight service in this area are now required to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities, P.O. Box 5427, St. John's, Newfoundland.

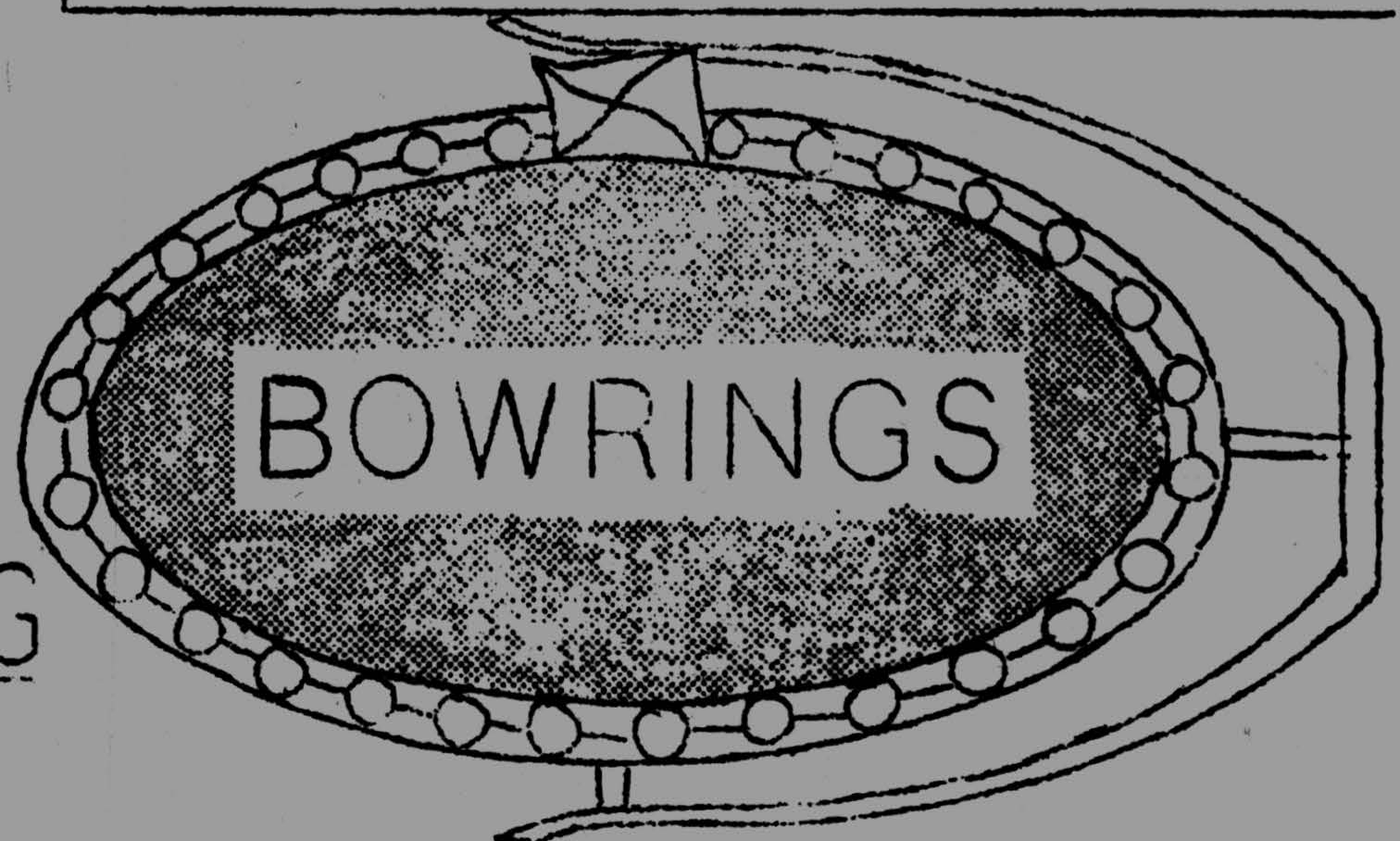

1 egg white
1 teacup brown sugar
 $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. vanilla essence

SIMPLE RECIPES TO CUT OUT & KEEP UNBAKED CHOCOLATE MACAROONS

METHOD: Toast peanuts in oven for a few minutes, then chop or mince coarsely, and sprinkle with salt. Put egg white on a large plate and beat to very stiff froth. Add sugar gradually, continuing to beat, flavour, and finally fold in nuts. Arrange teaspoonfuls of mixture on greased tin 1 inch apart, and bake in slow oven (300°F) till lightly browned and firm.

UNIVERSITY CREDIT COURSES

Memorial University of Newfoundland in Conjunction with the local Alumni Association will be offering two University courses for credit this year. One course will be French 100. This is first year University course in french intended for students who have completed grade 11 french.

The other, Education 125 is a maths course for primary and elementary teachers and deals with notions of the mathematics system with emphasis on properties of the Numbers System of arithmetic. This course is related to the modern mathematics course as introduced in the Elementary Schools.

There will be a fee of \$90 payable in advance and the course will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 1½ hours on each night.

These courses are scheduled to start on September 17 and registration will take place at the collegiate on that date.

Persons interested should have proof of grade 11 matriculation and should phone 944 - 2381 before September 16 stating their intentions to take either of the above mentioned courses.

During the next two weeks there will be further information announced regarding extension night courses for 1968 - 69.
