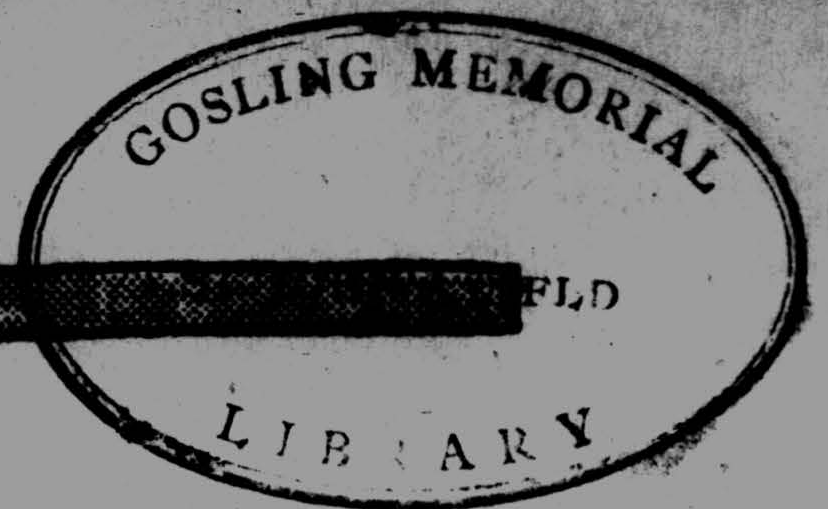

3. The RIGHT Invitation to accept:

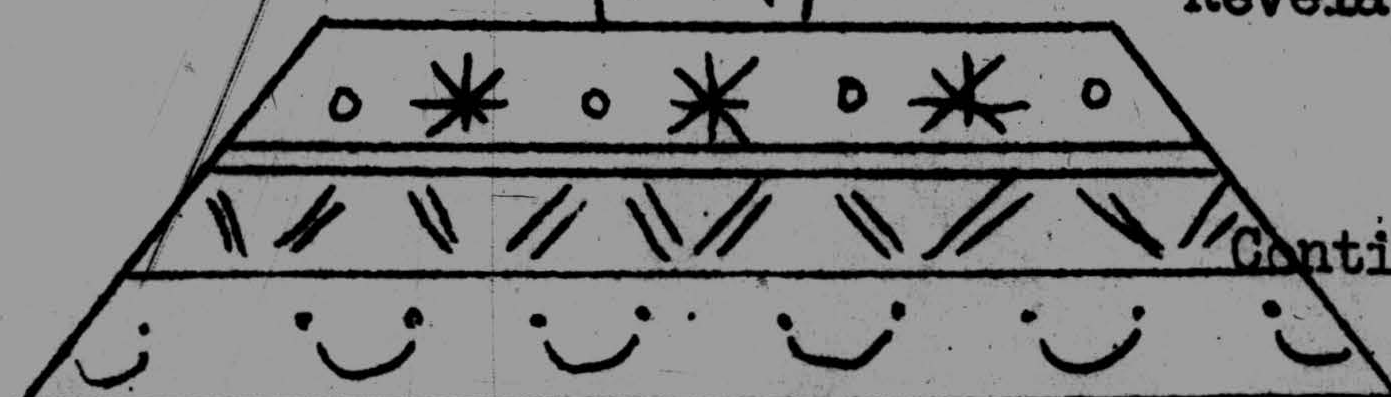
Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Matthew 11:28;

CHRISTMAS TREES - FIRE PREVENTION

YEAR AFTER YEAR THE QUESTION ARISES AS TO THE FIRE HAZARD OF CHRISTMAS TREES AND DECORATIONS. CHRISTMAS TREES AND DECORATIONS ARE RESPONSIBLE EACH YEAR FOR FIRES, MANY OF WHICH ARE AVOIDABLE IF SIMPLE PRECAUTIONS ARE TAKEN.

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL SAFETY MEASURES ARE SUGGESTED:

OBTAIN A FRESH TREE WHICH HAS BEEN STORED OUTDOORS AND KEEP OUTDOORS UNTIL ACTUALLY NEEDED. CUT OFF THE END OF THE TRUNK DIAGONALLY AT LEAST ONE INCH ABOVE THE ORIGINAL CUT END. STAND THE TREE, AT ONCE IN A CONTAINER OF WATER. TREE STANDS ARE AVAILABLE WITH A RESERVOIR IN WHICH THE TRUNK MAY BE SET. LENGTHWISE SAW CUTS IN THE BASE OF THE TRUNK WILL ALSO HELP THE TREE TO ABSORB WATER. BE SURE THE TREE IS WELL SUPPORTED AND SO LOCATED AS TO BE AWAY FROM FIREPLACES, RADIATORS, HEATING STOVES, RADIO AND TELEVISION SETS, OR OTHER SOURCES OF HEAT.

AVOID THE USE OF FLAMMABLE DECORATIONS ON OR NEAR THE TREE. TOY TRAINS, MOTORS OR ENGINES SHOULD NOT BE OPERATED UNDER OR NEAR THE TREE. USE ONLY ELECTRIC LIGHTS, AND SEE THAT ALL OF THE STRINGS ARE IN GOOD CONDITION AND NOT FRAYED. ELECTRICAL DEVICES SUCH AS TREE LIGHTING SETS, DECORATIVE LIGHTING OUTFITS AND EXTENSION CORDS SHOULD COMPLY WITH SAFETY STANDARDS OF UNDERWRITERS' LABORATORIES, INC.

DO NOT LEAVE TREE LIGHTS BURNING WHEN NO ONE IS IN THE HOUSE. FROM TIME TO TIME INSPECT THE TREE AND SEE WHETHER ANY OF THE NEEDLES NEAR THE LIGHTS HAVE STARTED TO BROWN, IF SO CHANGE THE LOCATION OF THE LIGHTS.

IF ANY DECORATIONS ARE USED ABOUT THE HOUSE, DO NOT PERMIT THEM TO BE AROUND OR NEAR CHAIRS AND OTHER PLACES WHERE PEOPLE MAY SMOKE.

IF LIGHTS ARE DESIRED IN WINDOWS, NEVER USE CANDLES; KEEP CURTAINS AND OTHER FLAMMABLE MATERIAL PULLED BACK AT LEAST 6 INCHES FROM ANY LIGHT.

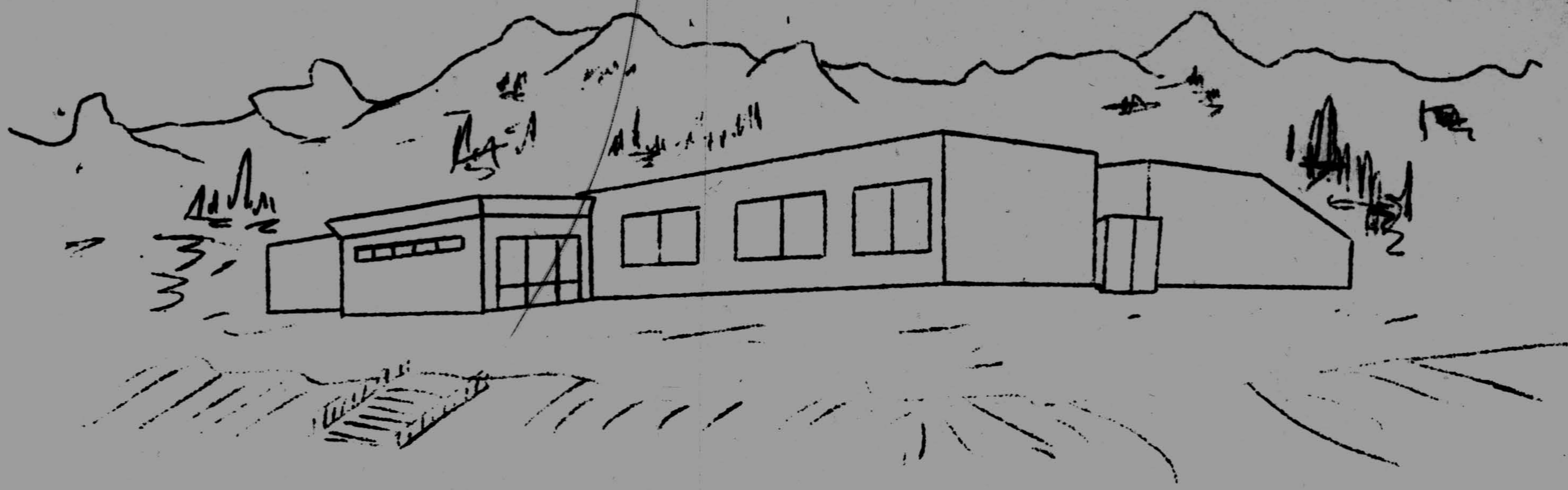

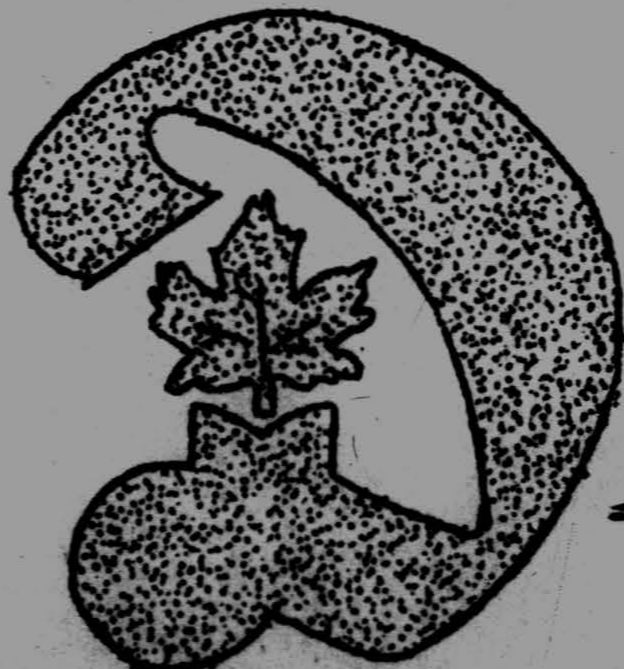

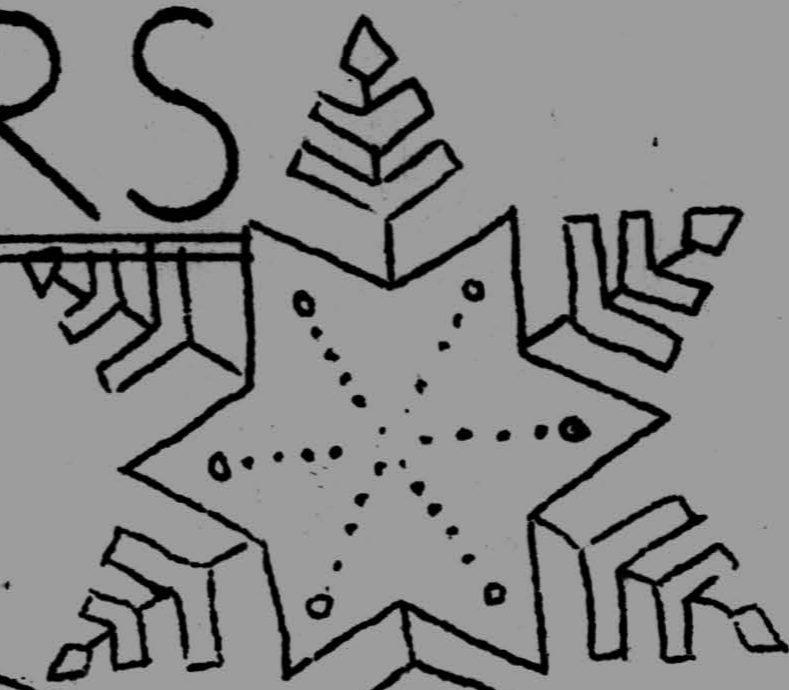
