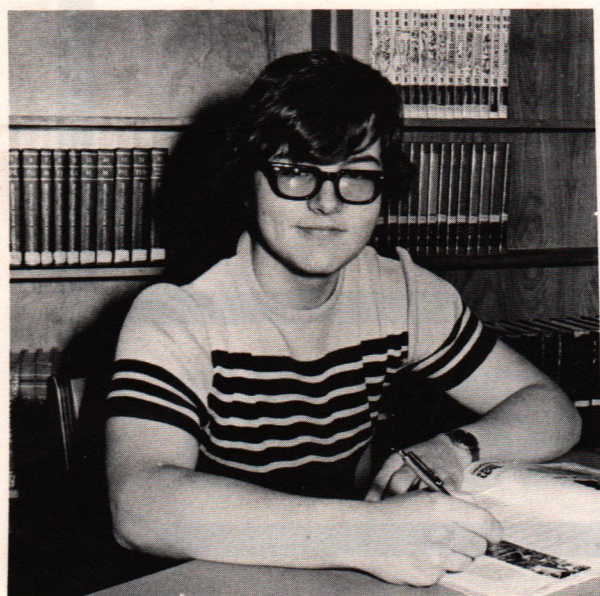




ACTIVITIES

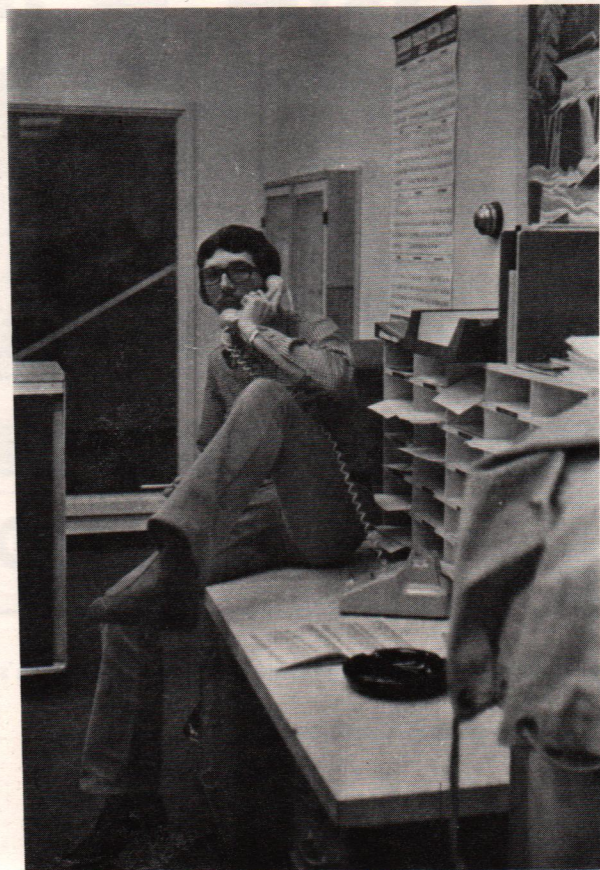
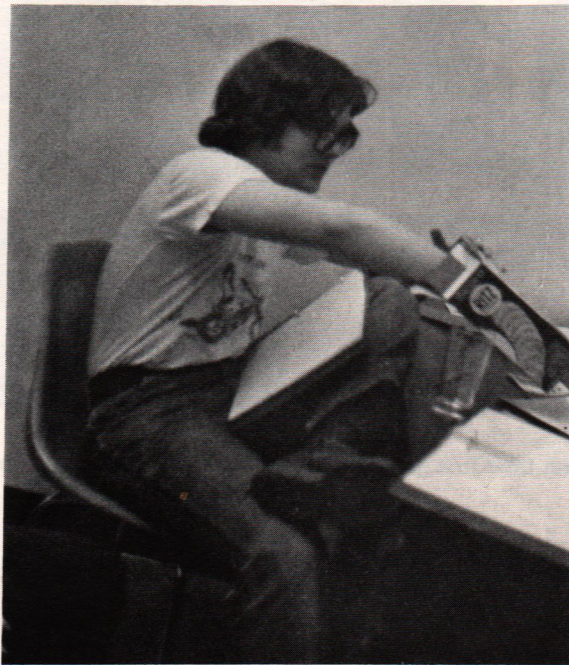

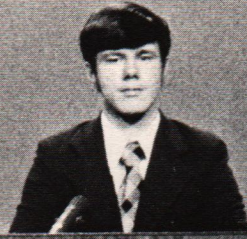

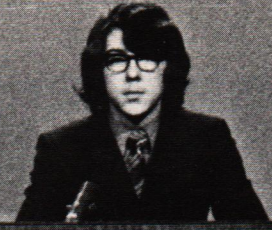

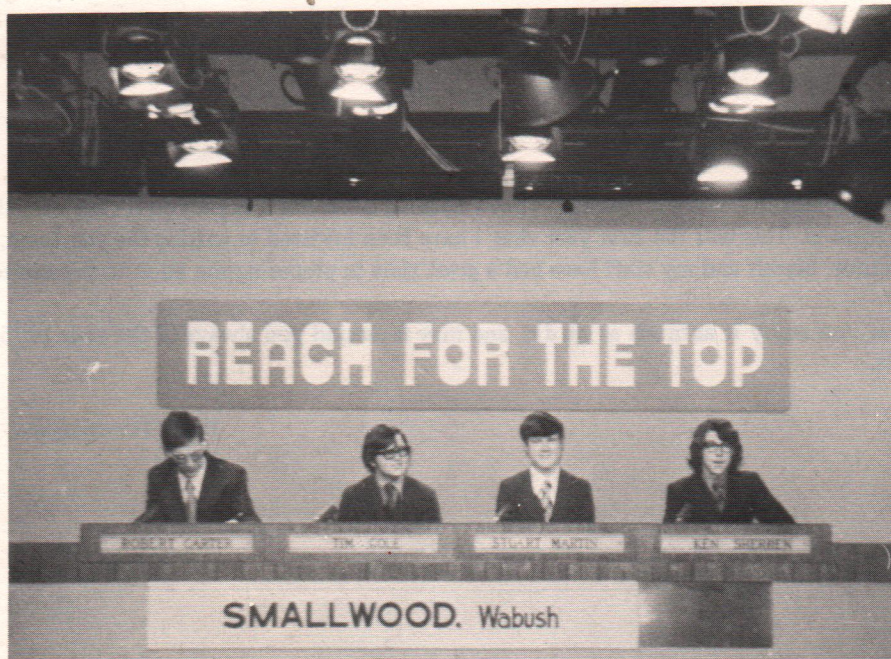

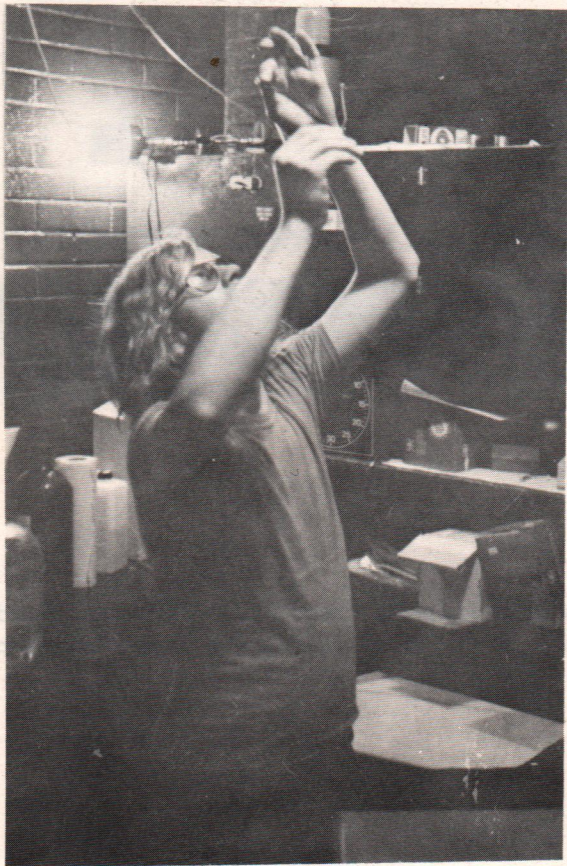

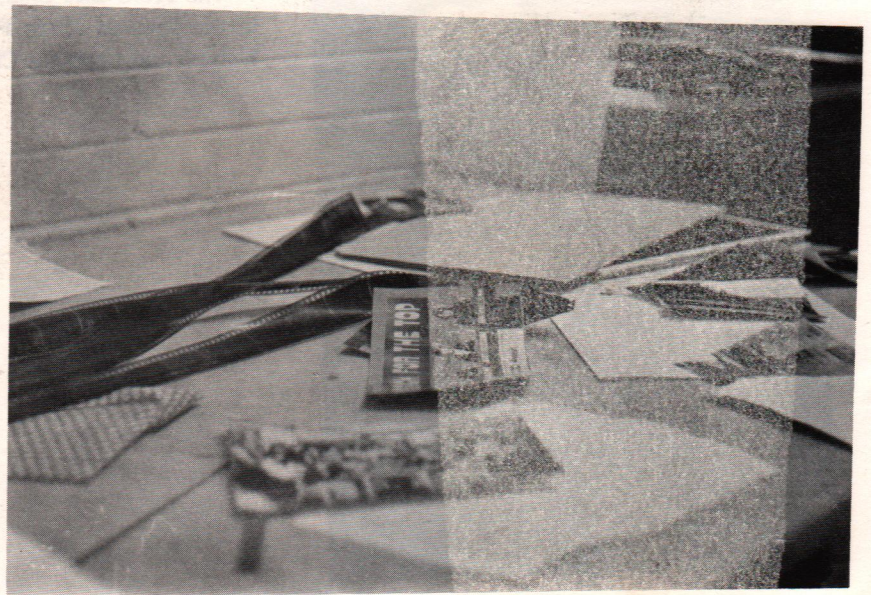

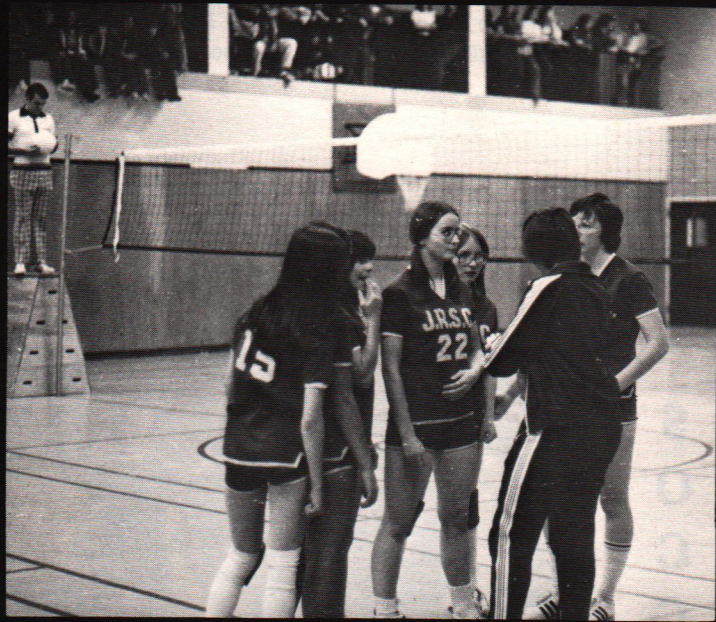
