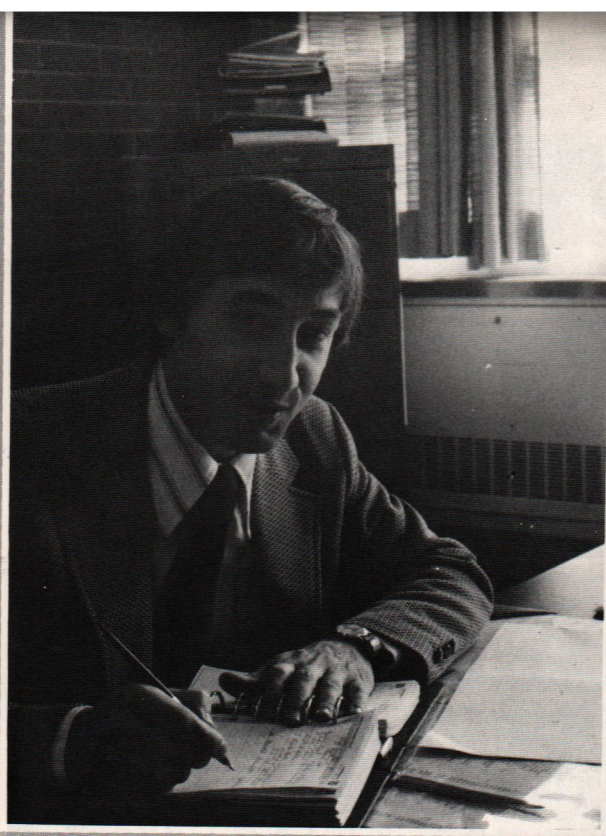
Graduates of 1977-78.

ISAAC GOULDING remembers Mr. Wicks' Volkswagen, especially the day he helped push it out into the driveway of the school; and the next day in the office.

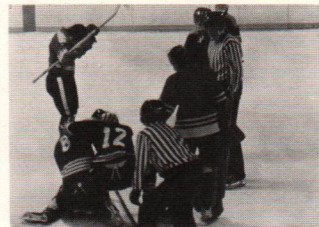
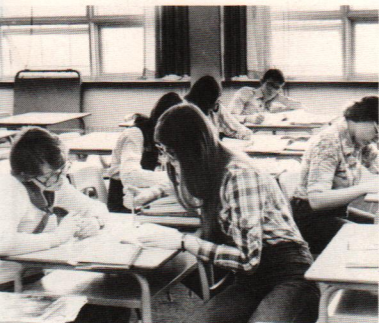
JULIE HART remembers the fun days in Grade 9 when they tired of work and held sit down strikes on the tables in Mr. Taylor's Math class.

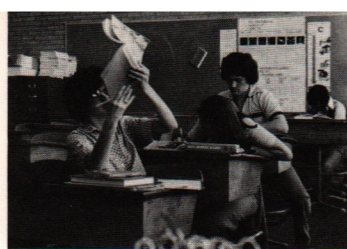
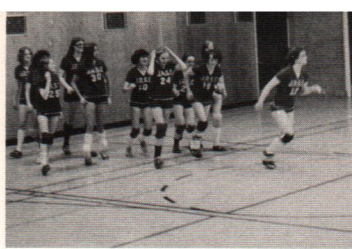
